



Hamilton Huskies Hockey Club Criminal Offence Declaration (2022-2023)

Every Hamilton Huskies Hockey Club ("Huskies") volunteer 18 years of age and older must have a valid Police Clearance on file with the Huskies [police clearances are valid for a period of 3 years]. If you are 18 or older or if your Police Clearance is about to expire you must apply for a new "Police Vulnerable Sector Check" (PVSC). If you have not obtained your Police Clearance you must do so before you may assume your volunteer duties. When a Police Clearance is issued, the original must be brought to the Huskies for validation. This declaration is NOT a substitute for an official Police Clearance.
